### Saturday Seminars

**Entrelac** - Saturday, Feb. 7, 2009 Time: 10:30 to 12:30 Cost: \$25

Ever wondered about entrelac and how to make those little diagonal squares? You can make scarves, afghans and even socks with this easy to learn technique! Materials: 200 grams of worsted weight yarn (this pattern works great with self striping yarn!), size 8 knitting needles and a copy of the Danica scarf pattern from knitty.com - <http://knitty.com/ISSUEwinter05/PATTdanica.html>. (Go to Legal Info on the Knitty website to see why I'm having you print out your own copy.)

**Felted Clogs** - Saturday, Feb. 14, 2009 Time: 10:30 to 4:30 Cost: \$50

Make these great felted clogs for everyone on your list! Learn to make short rows with wrap & turn, picking up stitches and three needle bind off. We will make one baby size clog in class and talk about felting techniques using your washing machine. Materials: 1 100 gram skein feltable worsted weight yarn such as Cascade 220 or Ella Rae Classic, size 13 circular needles in 16" length, a spare circular needle in a smaller size, Fiber Trends pattern #CH-38X for child's felted clogs, markers & a yarn needle. (Note: You'll need a total of 210 yards for the x-small clogs. The yarn is used double stranded so be sure your yarn is wound so that you can knit from both ends of the skein at once.)

**Two Hands, Two Colors, Two Hours** - Saturday, Feb. 21, 2009 Time: 10:30 to 12:30

Cost: \$25

Learn to make a quick headband using the two handed technique in only two hours! This method allows you to work without having to untwist your yarns. You will learn how to carry the color not used and read a graph, as well as European knitting. Materials: Two colors of bulky weight yarn, a 16" size 10 circular knitting needle & markers.

**Tips & Techniques** - Saturday, Feb. 28, 2009 Time: 10:30 to 12:30 Cost: \$25

This one includes the best of the best! Different ways to cast on and bind off, increase and decrease, fix mistakes, finishing techniques and more! Don't like that "jog" when you bind off a neckline in the round? Or when you do rows of bind offs at a neckline or armhole? I'll show you ways to avoid that. We'll talk about how to figure out what size sweater to make according to the pattern you're using, and how to avoid the "ladder" when you knit with double point needles. Materials: Light colored smooth bulky weight yarn, US size 10 or 10 ½ knitting needles, double point needles size 10 or 10 ½, a yarn needle and a size J or K crochet hook.
